Jul 19, 1887

Born in Schomberg, Ontario to John James Duncan and Susanna (Perry) Banting.

Age 35

Cecil Banting (age 35) married Alice Maude Francis (age 26), daughter of Henry and Rachel Ann (James) Francis of Stratford, Ontario. Alice and Cecil were both employed as clerks at the time. They had 2 children together: Robert and Muriel.

Jul 4, 1960

Age 72

Cecil died. He is buried at Sanctuary Park Cemetery in Weston, Ontario.
