EARLY LIFE

Dec 17, 1896

Born in Lloydtown, Ontario to James and Hannah Maude Mary (Wilson) Brydon.

1901 Census

Age 5

Lived in King, Ontario with James Brydon (head of house – father, age 47), Maude Brydon (mother, age 35) and Norman Reynar (employee, age 16).

1911 Census

Age 15

Lived in King, Ontario with Maude Brydon (head of house – mother, age 45) and Marie Brydon (sister, age 8).

Jan 22, 1918

Age 22

Married Gertrude “Gertie” Calhoun (age 21), daughter of James and Elizabeth (Sloan) Calhoun of Tecumseh, Ontario.
