
CHAPMAN, GEORGE FREDERICK

In 1942 he retired from farming and moved to Nobleton where he had a small garden and kept a few pigs until he died in 1957 at the age of ninety. His wife pre-deceased him in 1937. They had three sons and one daughter: Fred, Frank, Muriel and Gordon. Both Fred and Frank served during World War One in France and Russia. There are eleven grandchildren, thirteen great grandchildren and four greatgreat grandchildren.

Fred married Irene Whorley and they lived on the Tenth of King, Lot 4 for many years. They later moved to

Haileybury with their family, Margaret, Ruth and Robert. Irene died in 1969 and Fred still lives in Haileybury with his son Bob. Margaret (Mrs. Olson) now lives in Tillsonburg and Ruth (Mrs. Durkee) lives in Ohio in the United States.
