Born in King, Ontario Thomas Fortes and Amelia 'Minnie' (Cain) Lloyd.

Married Dora Lillian Morning (age 23), daughter of John and Mae (Bell) Morning.

Aug 14, 1977

Age 82

Thomas died in Elmvale, Ontario. He is buried at St. Patrick's Cemetery in Phelpston, Ontario.
