

# MCBRIDE, CHARLES WESTLEY

## EARLY LIFE

**Jul 26, 1882**

Born in King, Ontario to Isaac and Annie McBride.

**1891 Census**

Age 8

Lived in King, Ontario with Isaac McBride (head of house – father, age 55), Annie McBride (mother, age 50), Herman McBride (brother, age 29), Ida McBride (sister, age 25), Ella McBride (sister, age 22), Edgar McBride (brother, age 20), Edith McBride (sister, age 17), Orlington McBride (brother, age 15), Ethel McBride (sister, age 12) and Hazel McBride (sister, age 6).

**1901 Census**

Age 18

At age 18, Charles McBride lived in King, Ontario with Isaac McBride (head of house – father, age 65), Annie McBride (mother, age 60), Ella McBride (sister, age 31), Orlington McBride (brother, age 24) and Hazel McBride (sister, age 16).

**Nov 26, 1909**

Age 27

Married Mary Hoover (age 26), daughter of Michael and Mary Ann (Sutton) Hoover of King Township, Ontario. At the time of their wedding Charles worked as a labourer and Mary was a housemaid.
