Born in Nobleton, Ontario to Harvey Lackie and Elizabeth Frances (Starrett) Snider.

Albert died at York County Hospital in Newmarket, Ontario. He is buried in Laurel Hill Cemetery in Bolton, Ontario. He never married.

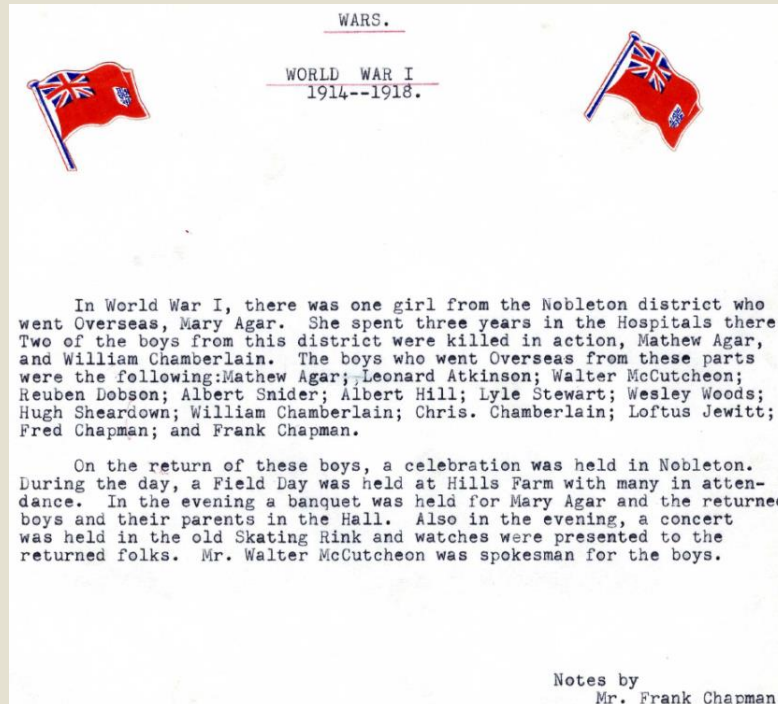
