EARLY LIFE

Aug 12, 1889

Born in Eversley, Ontario to Joseph Douglas and Bertha Nyachathe (Kirk) Tunney.

1891 Census

May 7, 1920

Age 30

1921 Census

Age 31

Lived at 93 Patterson Street in Simcoe, Ontario where he worked as a tanner. He lived with Marjory Tunney (wife, age 25).

Lived at 15 Huron Street West in Newmarket, Ontario with Marjory Tunney and worked as a mechanic.

Age 59

Leo died in Bracebridge, Ontario. He is buried in St. John's Cemetery.
