EARLY LIFE

Aug 12, 1893

Born in Aurora, Ontario to Henry and Amelia (Eade) Ward.

1901 Census

Age 7

Lived in King Township, Ontario with Henry Ward (head of house – father, age 46), Amelia Ward (mother, age 38), Rose Ward (sister, age 9), Elsie Ward (sister, age 4), and Gertrude Ward (sister, age 1).

1911 Census

Age 16

Lived in Vaughan, Ontario with Henry Ward (head of house – father, age 57), Amelia Ward (mother, age 49), Elsie Ward (sister, age 14), Gertrude Ward (sister, age 11), Jessie Ward (sister, age 5) and Rachel Eade (maternal grandmother, age 80).

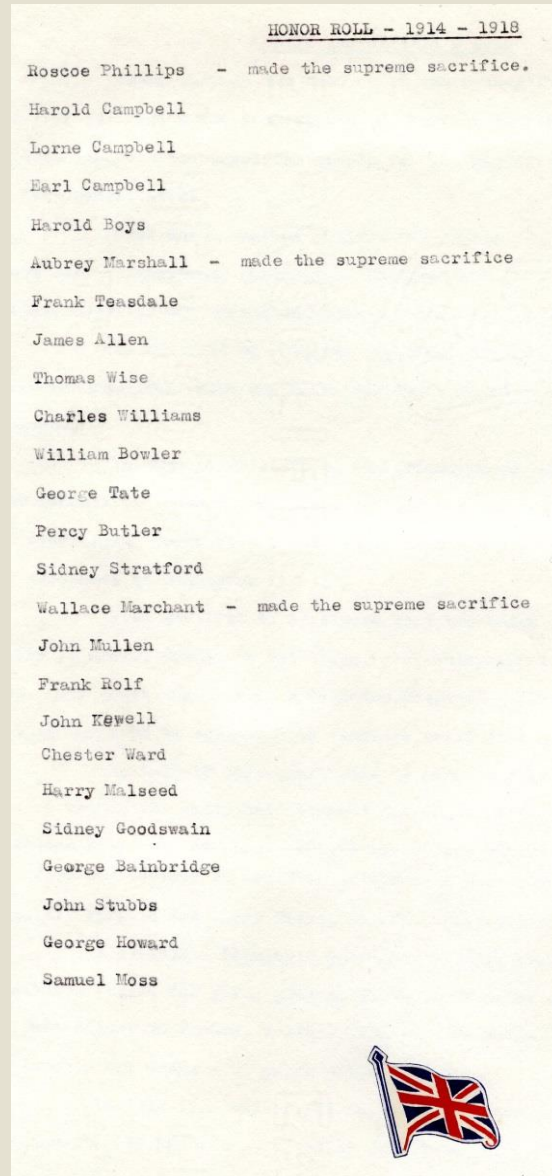
